1 Introduction

Congratulations on having your paper conditionally accepted for presentation and publication at the ACM SIGGRAPH 2012 conference.

This message contains information on the various deadlines and deliverables related to your paper and auxiliary material.

If you have any questions about the formatting or delivery of your material, please do not hesitate to ask. We're happy to help.

2 Final Paper PDF

As stated in your letter of acceptance, you must resolve all outstanding review issues with your referee, and upload the final, accepted version of your paper to the SIS by 09 May 2012. The paper must be formatted to the guidelines found at www.siggraph.org/publications/instructions.

Take special care to follow the instructions regarding typeface size and line spacing, and that all typefaces must be embedded in the PDF document. Should you be unable to embed all typefaces in your PDF, as part of the document preparation process, we'll need to work together to resolve this, once the paper's been officially accepted. The author instructions document contains a number of helpful hints to help with this process.

Please download and use the version of the "acmsiggraph" LaTeX class files available from www.siggraph.org/publications/acmsiggraph.zip - there are important changes and enhancements.

Final Paper Upload Deadline = 09 May 2012

Note that only the submitting author has "Edit" access to the submission form's Final Paper upload field.

3 Auxiliary Material

If you plan to submit auxiliary material - movies, images, source code, etc. - that material needs to be uploaded to the SIS no later than 09 May 2012. This material will be published on the Full Conference DVD-ROM on the same disc as the papers.

All auxiliary material should be collected into one ZIP file and uploaded to SIS. A "readme" file, containing an explanation of the contents of the ZIP file, should also be uploaded to SIS.

Please note that this includes the "papers video" - starting in 2010, videos which accompany accepted Technical Papers will be included with other auxiliary material, replacing the two "Papers Video" DVD discs.

Papers video should be no more than five minutes in length, and should be in QuickTime (preferred for compatibility), MPEG, or DivX formats. The H.264 and MJPEG codecs are preferred, for compatibility and quality. Resolution should be no greater than 720p (1280 × 720 pixels).

Auxiliary Material Deadline = 09 May 2012

4 Copyright Form

The primary author associated with each paper will receive information from ACM regarding the preparation and delivery of copyright information to ACM.

The copyright form and documentation of permission to use third-party material in your paper must be returned to ACM no later than 09 May 2012.

If you use any third-party material in your content, you must secure permission to use that content from the owners and provide documentation of the permission with your copyright form, as well as complete the "Third Party Material" section of the copyright form. ACM's policies and procedures for [handling third-party material](http://www.acm.org/publications/third-party-material) is highly recommended reading.

If you have any auxiliary material to make available, please complete the "Auxiliary Material" section of the copyright form.

5 Thumbnail Image

A single thumbnail image for each paper must be uploaded to SIS no later than 09 May 2012. **It needs to be in a 4:3 aspect ratio** (400 × 300 pixels, wider than it is tall, is sufficient resolution), to be used in the table of contents for the ACM SIGGRAPH 2012 special issue of ACM Transactions on Graphics. This image should be representative of the work in your paper. (For examples of representative thumbnail images, see last year's book.)
