2) ACM SIGGRAPH Village at SIGGRAPH 2022 (AJ)

- a) AJ shared a slide deck and walked the EC through the slides.
- b) In-person-
 - Village Lounge- Located in Pan Pacific Hotel meeting room, distant walk from conference events. Conceived of as a place for org volunteers to relax, leave stuff, grab snacks, take calls, etc. Might be redundant of Conference management, and we are skeptical whether anyone will use it.
 - ii)
- c) Virtual
 - i) Virtual Village Square- hosted in Gather.Town, the org can be laid out on the "game map". We did this last year, we thought it was successful.

Should this be an idling space or an active community center? If active, when? Aka will the on-site conference dampen or energize the virtual conference?

ii) Virtual Village Sessions- These should NOT be referred to as BOFs. Highly recommended that these get scheduled in the 2 weeks preceding the on-site conference so that our volunteer work force isn't pulled in two directions. The original plan was to hold these on external BOFs. Now the recommendation is to hold them in the Notified (formerly Hubb) BOF format. This means no recordings survive after the conference. This means no unregistered guests. This leads to a conflict between conference prices and backdoors.
