
SIGGRAPH Asia 2023 Sets New Heights for Innovation in Sydney and Gears Up for Next Edition in Tokyo

Introducing the ACM SIGGRAPH Underrepresented Communities Travel Grant

Applications Open:1 December, 2023Applications Close:13 March, 2024Acceptances:3 April, 2024

ACM SIGGRAPH offers support to new and existing members of the SIGGRAPH community whose potential career impact is recognized as extraordinary and who can demonstrate financial need to attend SIGGRAPH 2024. This grant intends to simultaneously highlight SIGGRAPH's abiding recognition of the value that diversity from underrepresented groups brings to computer graphics and interactive techniques and its future positive impact to ACM SIGGRAPH communities and society.

Eligibility Requirements:

Any ACM SIGGRAPH member (professional or student) in the field of computer graphics and interactive techniques but not limited to, technology innovations, artistic production, education, societal services, leadership and/or broader impacts within those industries.

Grantees may receive only one grant per conference year.

Budget requests and reimbursement are subject to the ACM SIGGRAPH travel policies.

These grants will be awarded to individuals from underrepresented communities in the CG/IT fields listed in ACM SIGGRAPH annual demographic surveys and questionnaires. Nominees from universities, NGO's, industry, and governmental organizations including students, early career, industry, and academic professionals in the CG/IT domains will be considered and are encouraged to apply for travel grant support.

How It Works:

Submit a nomination single PDF packet which includes a potential contribution statement of the candidate in expression of financial need to <u>urt@siggraph.org</u> by **13 March 2024.** The packet should include the following information:

How do you identify with underrepresented communities?

Tell us about your personal experiences in supporting underrepresented communities (professionally, within CG/IT, or otherwise). What were the effects?

How is your work conducive to diversity in ACM SIGGRAPH?

Can you elaborate on your financial needs and how the grant would support your attendance at this year's conference?

Please include 1-page Cover Letter (1,000 word limit)

Please include 1 page C.V./resume.

Please include letters of recommendation ((500 word limit) each due with application materials).

Review Process:

A selection committee of current ACM SIGGRAPH members will review all the nominations.

Grantees:

All grantees will be selected by **3 April, 2024**, and will be invited to attend SIGGRAPH 2024 in Denver, Colorado. Grantees will receive a Full Conference Pass in addition to receiving financial support reimbursing documented cost of SIGGRAPH 2024 attendance.* Please note that included in the award is a one-year ACM SIGGRAPH Membership.

Publicity:

Any information supplied for the application must not be confidential and can be used for publicity purposes by ACM SIGGRAPH. Awardees give ACM SIGGRAPH permission to use representative images of their work, member profiles, stories, subsequent activities in connection with the ACM SIGGRAPH community and organization, etc. for use in ACM SIGGRAPH publications, at conferences sponsored by ACM and/or ACM SIGGRAPH, or other publicity purposes.

Conflict of Interest:

ACM's conflict-of-interest (COI) guidelines apply to all award nominations. The ACM SIGGRAPH Award Chair and the ACM SIGGRAPH Executive Committee are responsible for ensuring the COI guidelines are followed and resolving any issues that cannot be resolved by the respective Award Committee Chair.


Apply to the ACM Women in Computer Graphics (WiGRAPH) Rising Stars Program
