ACM SIGGRAPH regrets to announce the death of Hungarian-French artist Vera Molnár. Awarded the 2022 ACM SIGGRAPH Distinguished Artists Award for Lifetime Achievement in Digital Art, Molnár co-founded two groups focusing on the use of technology within the arts; Groupe de Recherche d'Art Visuel and Art et Informatique.
