ACM is now requiring that all authors of works accepted to ACM journals and transactions, including TOG and PACMCGIT, have valid ORCID identifiers, and plan to expand this requirement to all of ACM's publications, including conference proceedings, by the end of 2022.

ORCID identifiers can be obtained at <https://orcid.org/register>, and ACM only requires you to complete the initial registration process.
