The ACM SIGGRAPH Underrepresented Communities Travel Grant supports new and current SIGGRAPH members with exceptional career potential and financial need to attend SIGGRAPH 2025.

- Applicants from universities, NGOs, industry, and government organizations, including students, early-career professionals, and those in academia or industry, are encouraged to apply.


## **Explore Indigenous Innovation in Digital Art**
