The deadline has been extended to Thursday, 1 May 2025 for the ACM SIGGRAPH Underrepresented Communities Travel Grant.

The ACM SIGGRAPH Underrepresented Communities Travel Grant supports new and current SIGGRAPH members with exceptional career potential and financial need to attend SIGGRAPH 2025.

Eligibility:

- Open to ACM SIGGRAPH members (professional or student) in the field of computer graphics and interactive techniques, including areas like technology, art, education, societal services, leadership, and broader impacts.
- This grant is specifically for individuals from underrepresented communities in CG/IT, as identified in ACM SIGGRAPH's annual demographic surveys.
- Applicants from universities, NGOs, industry, and government organizations, including students, early-career professionals, and those in academia or industry, are encouraged to apply.


